
Two key developments

- Partial centralisation of the welfare system (from 2010)
 - Start of Udbetaling Danmark 2012 and formalised cooperation with municipalities (through the Act on Udbetaling Danmark)
 - 2012-2015 UDK takes over the responsibility for 10 municipal welfare areas


• Basic Data Programme (from 2013)

- The creation of digital registries, e.g. The Civil Registration System, the Central Business Register, and the Building and Housing Register
- Accessible through web services and APIs
- Application of the once-only principle
